ABSTRACT

Dental education, like Medical education in our country, should now be shifted towards student centered, be Evidence cum Competence based & incorporate room for Faculty Development to meet International trends. This special GJC dentistry commentary is dedicated to the academic contributions of our entire respected LMC dentistry faculty from a lecturer to the level of professor, who taught & trained us to play vital academic role, from the year 1963 till 2013. This commentary is contribution to share our academic role for the promotion of our dynamic skill oriented Oral Health Profession in Pakistan.

INTRODUCTION

The fifty years of our alma mater Liaquat University of Medical & Health Sciences, Jamshoro has seen many ups & downs. It is hoped that, this commentary will serve as a Pathfinder document for other Dental & Medical Educationists to explore, document & promote other areas of interest related to Oral Health Sciences Profession in Pakistan. In order to fill the vast gaps present in national Dental Education, this commentary is being shared on the occasion of Golden Jubilee celebration Year 2013 of our Dental Section, affiliated with Liaquat Medical College-Jamshoro. This department has now been upgraded into Institute of Dentistry, Liaquat University of Medical & Health Sciences and it has the honor to be Pakistan's 1st Public Sector Medical University & respective Dental Institute. It was established via an ordinance in 2001 to promote Medical & Dental Education, Training and Research^{1,2}. This article would fulfill the objectives of: Contribution to Dental Education, provide an update on Present status of Dental Institutes of two Provinces of our country, highlight the academic contributions of LMC dental Graduates & its respective Heads at an Undergraduate level from 1963 till 2013 & also suggest recommendations, for all concerned. A similar academic contribution has already been documented by our colleagues.2

Present scenario and what to do?

Currently, there are 15 Dental Colleges in Sindh & only one in Balochistan Province. All these are ap-

proved, but a few are at initial recognition levels by the regulatory body of Pakistan Medical & Dental Council (PMDC). In Sindh Province, from all these, 11 are heavily concentrated in Karachi, whereas, one dental college each is located in cities of: Jamshoro, Hyderabad, Mirpurkhas & Larkana. Interestingly among these, 10 belong to the specialty of oral surgery reflecting their possible academic association to the pioneer LMC academic leadership. The present Pakistan dental academic scenario 2013/14 shows, that, there is still a major shortage of highly educated & technically skilled faculty at most of the dental Institutes, at both Public & Private sector³.

Action, in terms of Positive Academic Support at all levels needs to be taken by all leading stake holders, in order to upgrade our current dental education & Profession, to meet our society & International standard^{1,3}. This is only possible by providing a positive & supportive learning environment for the new dental graduates to foster "Critical thinking & their development as Academic Leaders, to train them to think & act out of the box 4". Education, Research and Oral Health Care targeted for patient's forms the most vital platform for any Dental Institute and cater to the society needs & this must be addressed nationally⁴. The Private Dental sector seems to have taken the lead in Pakistan by establishing numerous dental institutes, focusing more on Quantity, neglecting Quality & associated Hospital based dental Clinical training and that, they need to play their active roles to promote & modify the present dental education scenario 1,3,4

RECOMMENDATIONS

The 7- rainbow colored recommendations to be addressed nationally, at undergraduate level by: Government of Pakistan, PMDC/HEC, Dental/Medical Institute stake holders, respective Educationists, with the support of our Medical Fraternity to promote Dental Education/ Profession are as under:

- Maintain Data: In terms of Dental Faculty profile, graduate pass outs, Post graduation Program details, dental graduate's migration etc. This data must be documented though internet to obtain all associated benefits similar to international trends 3,4
- Incorporate & emphasize Social Determinants/ Responsibilities As for Medical Profession, this should also be addressed & prioritized in Dental Education with revised curriculum related to our own needs ^{5,6}.
- Upgrade the existing undergraduate BDS Program to 5 or 6 years, with greater emphasis on teaching the subjects of General Medicine & General Surgery to meet International trends. This will greatly support Oral & Maxillofacial Surgical Specialty aspiring PG trainees to get international benefits ³.
- Establish Dental/Medical Education Department to cater to our own respective Professional needs, similar to Medical Profession. It should be made mandatory by PMDC/HEC for all Public Sector Medical University based Dental Institutes to take a lead from year 2016. This will enable them to emerge as National academic leaders. Finally, be made mandatory for all Private Sector Dental Colleges from 2017 3.4.7.8.
- **Shift Dental Education:** Similar to the Medical education, be shifted towards student centered, incorporate adult learning principles, be Evidence cum Competence based, create an active learning environment & room for Faculty Development to get international status^{3,4,7,8}.
- Introduce 4 new Subjects from 2016 Behavioral Sciences, Research Methodology-Biostatistics, Geriatric Dentistry & Forensic Odontology at an Undergraduate level, especially at all Public Sector Medical University based Dental Institutes to address our community needs, attain International

standards & emerge as Academic leaders ^{2,3, 10,11}

Establish Oral Cancer Oncology & Rehabilitation Centre by each Public Sector Medical University in each Province of Pakistan from 2015. This will permit to combat the Oral Malignancy/ Squamous Cell Carcinoma associated casualties in Pakistan, having one of the highest incidences in world ¹².

CONCLUSION

The international dynamic dental & medical Educationists, belonging to the Y-Generation has awareness of (IW) Intellectual Wellness. Similarly, IW should also be promoted by dental faculty, to maintain a balance between their careers & personal lives in our country. 9,11 In this interesting new journey of Faculty development, let's hope that Professionalism, Moral & Ethics as non-academic attributes of our dental curriculum are not forgotten in their true spirit⁸. We hope that, all the Dental & Medical Educationists and related Stake holders in this sarvy IT era would develop: a Positive Attitude, broadens their vision, & adapts an Open heart cum door policy to support the dynamic critically thinking academic Change Agents.
